



Statement Pro Human Intelligence (HI) Public fundraising (Crowdfunding).

Dear signatory,

as you may have noticed, you can sign the Pro Human Intelligence Statement for free. However, OSSMED Ets is a non-profit organization, and to implement this six-month campaign, we also need your financial support. That is why we have engaged the “GoFundMe” agency, which is specialized in fundraising for projects of high social value. Fundraising target: €50,000.

What will we do with the donations received?

We will use them to carry out the following actions, which require not only a lot of volunteering, but also paid human resources and the purchase of services:

- Information campaign through the media.
- A regular newsletter to inform signatories about campaign developments and relevant national and international legislative updates.
- Opinion poll open to subscribers and publication of a Report.
- Awarding of two scholarships to young researchers.
